Sir,

The SVP National Police Academy is organizing a two day Conference on 'Radicalization and De-radicalization of Youth' from 4-5 May, 2017 for the officers of the rank of Addl.SP to ADG.

The Conference will be organized on the following themes :

- (i) Understanding the extent of the problem & its impact on us
- (ii) Reasons for Radicalization
- (iii) Current efforts to approach the problem
- (iv) Role of Police, Communities, Families, NGOs' etc. in de-radicalization.
- (v) Designing a policy frame work to tackle the issue.

3. Experts from academia and field will be invited to speak on the themes of the Conference as given above. It is also proposed to hold four to five presentations of 15 minutes each on the experiences and initiatives taken by the State/ Organization etc. on this issue. These presentations and sharing of best practices would go a long way in positive implementation of the theme of the Conference.

4. Hence, you are requested to send the names of Officers interested to give a presentation on the above themes and the experience/best practices/ initiatives taken in this area of de-radicalization of youth. The presentation should be of 15 minutes followed by discussion and they should be sent to e-mail [njgupta@svpnpa.gov.in](mailto:njgupta@svpnpa.gov.in) latest by 15<sup>th</sup> April, 2017 for further action by the Academy. In addition to above, Officers of the rank of Addl. SP to ADG, may be nominated (2 main plus 2 reserve) for attending the above said Conference, alongwith their contact details, email id etc.

5. The nominations for the conference may also be sent to the Academy latest by 15<sup>th</sup> April, 2017 through Fax (040-24015179) / E-mail ([seniorcourse@svpnpa.gov.in](mailto:seniorcourse@svpnpa.gov.in)) for acceptance and forwarding joining instructions to the nominated officers directly. The postal address, telephone/mobile number, fax number & E-Mail ID of the nominated officers alongwith their batch seniority may also be intimated.

6. The conference is residential and the participants of the conference will be accommodated in the campus. The expenditure to be incurred on boarding and lodging of the participants shall be met by the Academy. However, the expenditure on account of travel of officers for attending the course may be borne by the respective State Government / organization. It is also reiterated that as per SOP of the Academy, nominations of only those Officers who have not undergone any Course (except ITC/MCTP) in this Academy during the 12 months preceding the start of the Conference on De-radicalization of Youth, shall be accepted. In addition, as per SOP of the Academy those Officers against whom criminal case, DE/PE etc. is in currency or contemplated are also not eligible to undergo any training programme/course etc. at the Academy. Hence, nominations of eligible Officers may only be sent accordingly.

7. A list of Officers who had given their willingness to develop domain expertise in "Counter Terrorism/Counter Insurgency" is enclosed herewith as Annexure-A to this letter. It is requested that while nominating Officers for above-said course, the DGs may give preference to these Officers from their respective States/UTs and they are exempt from the condition as envisaged at para 6 above, wherein it has been laid down that ~~nominations of only those officers who have not undergone any course in this Academy during the last 12 months shall be accepted.~~

8. The dress order for the conference participants is Civvies i.e. shirt (full sleeves) & Trouser for gentlemen and Salwar Kameez / Saree / Business Suit for ladies.

9. The nominees may be advised to proceed for the Conference only after receiving confirmation of acceptance of their nominations from the Academy. The officers whose nominations have been accepted are required to report at the Academy by the evening of 3<sup>rd</sup> May, 2017, i.e. one day before the commencement of the Conference. Transport from Hyderabad Airport / railway station to the Academy and back will be provided by the Academy.

Joining Instructions for 2 day Conference on 'Radicalization and De-radicalization of Youth' at SVPNPA, Hyd. on 4-5 May, 2017.

Reception, Accommodation and Boarding:

Only those officers, who have not undergone any training programmes in the Academy (excluding MCTP and ITC or have been nominated by their State/Dept. for developing domain expertise) in last 12 months, preceding the first day of Conference shall be nominated.

Officers nominated for the Conference, on getting confirmation from the Academy, should intimate their travel plans well in advance (Fax No.040-24015179) to enable the Academy to provide them transport at the Airport/ railway station. In case they are unable to locate the Academy vehicle on arrival, participants should contact MT Section incharge Telephone 040-24234455 or 040-24234646 for assistance.

SVP NPA also facilitates the participants to register their travel plans and other details through automated software. Once nomination is accepted the participants will get SMS alert on their registered mobile No. and email id showing the link to submit travel details of the participant. The accommodation and vehicle arrangements etc. shall be arranged and informed to the participant through SMS & email.

As SVP NPA is conducting several Senior Courses back to back and sometimes more than one Course is conducted at a time, there is a crunch for accommodation at times. It is therefore, laid down that the participants for various Course, shall arrive for the Course only one day prior to commencement of their Course and shall leave the Academy by next day after conclusion of the Course. All participants are requested to make their travel plans accordingly. As per the travel plan to be intimated by each participant, arrangement for reception and transport at the Airport will be made by the NPA. Upon arrival, the participants shall report to the senior officers' mess. Besides, no changes for accommodation shall be entertained once the same has been allotted.

The Conference is residential and officers will be housed in the accommodation provided by the Academy. The expenditure to be incurred on boarding and lodging of the participants will be met by the Academy in respect of all Officers attending the Conference. However, the expenditure on account of travel of officers for attending the Conference is to be borne by the State Government. The expenditure on boarding and lodging of any family member accompanying the participant has to be borne by the participant.

### Dress Order:

For all Indoor classes – Full sleeved Shirt & Trouser and formal shoes for gentlemen. Saree/Salwar Kameez/Business suit for ladies. For Outdoor activities/Sports (optional)- Sports dress with sports shoes (predominantly white).

For formal functions – Business suit/ full sleeve shirt with trousers for gentlemen and Saree/Salwar Kameez/ business suit for ladies.

### Discipline

- (i) Only those officers who have no disciplinary/criminal proceedings pending against them are **eligible** to attend the Conference.
- (ii) Each participant is requested to observe discipline as required in the Outdoor, Indoor sessions & mess and Service Etiquette throughout their stay in the Academy. Officers should not come to the Mess lounge in casuals (e.g. chappals, Kurta Pyjama etc.). They are also advised not to move in the campus in chappals, kurta pyjama etc. Smoking in all buildings, training areas and on the roads in the campus is strictly prohibited.

### Climatic Conditions:

At Hyderabad, climate is usually pleasant. Participants may check climate at the time of Course.

### Facilities Available:

Service of Officers' Club and laundry are available on payment basis at SVP NPA. Participants can avail the basic medical facilities from the Academy, if required, and avail facilities of Bank, Cooperative Stores and Post Office located at the NPA. Academy will not provide any vehicle for the participants or their spouses to go to city or other personal uses. However, a taxi can be arranged on payment if so requested by the participant.

### Pay and Leave:

All participants will draw their pay and allowances from their State/Organization and they will not be allowed to avail any kind of leave during the Conference time. They must make suitable arrangements so that they are not called for duties like court evidence etc., during the Conference. ~~No officer will be permitted to leave till the conclusion of the Valedictory session of the Conference.~~

### Return Journey Reservation

Officers are advised to secure reservations for their return journey before departure from their headquarters. This would obviate the difficulty in getting reservations from Hyderabad.
